

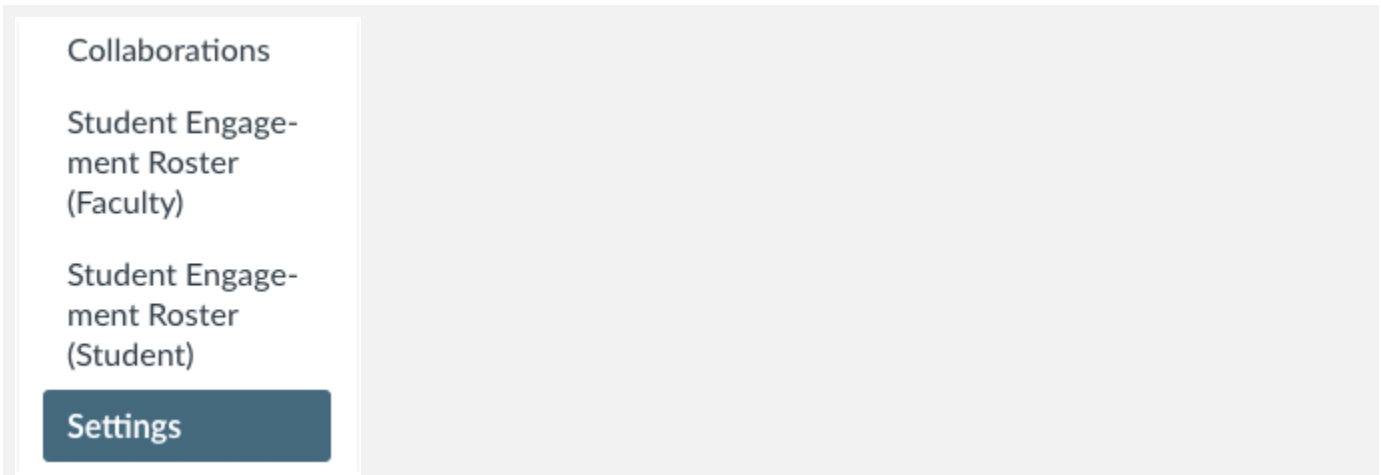
Adding Streaming Media Course Reserves to a Canvas Site

How To Guide - Adding *IU Media Collections Online* to Site Navigation

Step 1: Go to Canvas Site's Settings Page



In the [Course Navigation Menu](#), click the **Settings** link (this will most likely be at the bottom of the Course Navigation list).

In the Settings page, click the **Navigation** tab.

Step 2: Enable the *IU Media Collections Online* link in Navigation
